The Payne County Fair Royalty Competition is a natural, local county fair contest providing an opportunity for young people to develop their skills in talent, stage presence, public speaking, and community service.

Age Divisions

Princess 5-7 | Preteen 8-10 | Teen 11-14 | Queen 15-18 | Prince 5-11 | King 12-18

Applications will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Limited to 12 contestants per age division. Orientation is mandatory and will be held Saturday, August 22, 2026 at 10 am at the Payne County Expo Center.

Talent

May include song, dance, poetry reading, humor, cheerleading, drama, monologue or musical instruments. Contestants must provide their own instruments and accompaniment. You may have one person help with props. All talent performances must not exceed 3 minutes. Going over the allotted time will result in a 5-point penalty on the contestant's overall talent score. Garments for talent must be age appropriate.

Stage Presence

All outfits should be appropriate for the contestant's age. Attire should have a proper fit and should compliment the contestant and their personality. A pattern of X's will be on the stage in a "T" formation. The contestant's biography will be read out loud during the modeling. If you have questions on wardrobe, please call or email the pageant director (see info below).

Interview

All contestants will introduce themselves and answer an age appropriate question in a blind drawing. Garments worn during the stage presence competition will also be worn during the Interviews and Awards Ceremony presentation.

Entry Deadline

Please complete the application prior to the deadline on August 15, 2026 at midnight. No application will be accepted after this date. All applications will be processed in the order they are received and a contestant is not entered until the director receives the application. A letter will be sent to the email provided acknowledging receipt of the application and provide more information.
